Did You Know?

- ◆ Lewis brought his dog, Seaman, with him on the expedition. He was useful because he acted as a guard dog for the group. Indians once kidnapped Seaman, but the explorers rescued him!
- ◆ Lewis and Clark encountered many dangerous animals on their trip. They came across eight foot tall grizzly bears, rattlesnakes, and herds of 3000 to 10,000 buffalo!
- ◆ Lewis and Clark kept detailed journals during the expedition. They described 180 new plants and 125 new animals that scientists hadn't known before.
