SHAVING CREAM SENSORY ACTIVITY



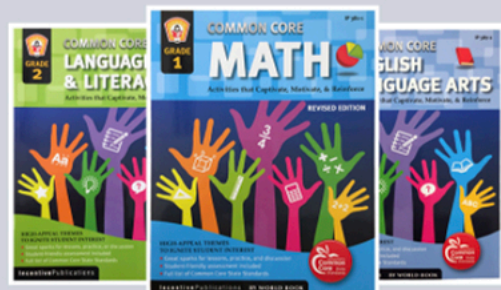
Use shaving cream for a fun, creative project! Kids can design clouds & mountains, and even use plastic animals and cars for story-making.
