## Download the app and log on

Visit the Google Play Store, for Android products, or the Apple AppStore, for iOS devices, to download the app.


1. Search: World Book eBooks
2. Tap on the icon to download the app.
3. When complete, the app can be launched from your home screen.
4. Log on with your personal eBooks account. If you do not have one, visit World Book eBooks on your browser to create one.

## Download and view books

1. Launch the World Book eBooks app.
2. Log on with your personal eBooks account and scroll to see all ebooks available.
3. Choose the menu at the top left corner of your screen to filter by category or see titles you've previously downloaded. 
4. To download a title, tap on the download icon in the center of the book. 
5. All titles you have downloaded will be in the "Show Downloaded" section.

## Make the books your own

### On the app:

1. Open any title and tap the screen in the middle.
2. Choose from the menu options at the top to create notes, highlights, and bookmarks; add custom drawings to the pages; search; or view your personalized work.
3. Select the Table of Contents in the lower left corner to view pages, bookmarks, and interactivity.
4. To exit a book, tap on the shelf icon found on the top left corner. 

### On a browser:

1. Select a book to view the full title, author, and description. Choose the "Open" button to view the book.
2. Choose from the menu options at the top left to create notes, highlights, and bookmarks; add custom drawings to the pages; search; or view your personalized work. You can also zoom in on the pages or make the book full-screen.
3. Select the Table of Contents in the top left corner to view pages, bookmarks, and interactivity.
4. On the bottom menu, toggle between single-page view and double-page view or view the pages in thumbnails.
5. To exit a book, tap on the shelf icon found on the top left corner.
