HOW MANY CLASSES CAN I CREATE?

You can create as many classes as you want. Each class you create will generate a class code that your students can use to join a class.

CAN I ASSIGN CONTENT TO STUDENTS?

Yes! You have the option to assign to the entire class or individuals within a class making differentiation easy. Additional options allow you to set a due date, assign content ahead of time, add resources, and more!

CAN I MONITOR STUDENT PROGRESS?

Yes! Monitor progress from afar with built in reporting metrics, including proficiency levels and learning minutes.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A COURSE AND A DRILL?

A **drill** is an exercise to practice material for a single topic. A **course** is a collection of drills on a subject. Courses take longer to complete than an individual drill.

DO THE DRILLS CORRELATE TO STANDARDS?

Yes! Drills correlate to many different sets of standards, including Common Core, International Baccalaureate, state standards, and so much more.
