# CAN I LEAVE A DRILL AND COME BACK TO IT LATER?

# WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A COURSE AND A DRILL?

A **drill** is an exercise to practice material for a single topic. A **course** is a collection of drills on a subject. Courses take longer to complete than an individual drill.

#### HOW CAN I EARN REWARDS?

You can earn fun rewards on *Wizard*, including badges and games, by completing drills and courses! You'll find these on the Rewards tab.

*Wizard* will tell you which drills and courses to complete in order to earn badges. Try to collect them all!

You can also unlock Legends of Learning games by practicing on *Wizard*. Once unlocked, you can find them in your secret game stash. These games are a secret, so *Wizard* will not tell you which drills/courses you have to complete to earn them. See how many you can find!
