#### Cross the curriculum

Ideas using the Create a Timeline feature.



- A get-to-know you tool
  - Students can create a timeline about their lives, summer, etc. as a get to know you activity.
- Reading log
  - Students can track the books they're reading and use the description box to summarize the plot, review the book, and so on.
- Biography
  - Students can use Timelines as a presentation or assessment tool to complete a biography project.
- Daily Writing Prompts
  - Students can create a digital journal and answer daily writing prompts right on their timelines!
- Current Events log
  - Students can track important events over the course of the year in digital timeline format.
