




# Tips for Teachers

with Student




## Share content with direct links!



- Save your students time and make sure they find the correct resource by using direct links.
- Look for the "Copy Link" button in the Tools menu under Share.

## Compare Places:


Have students compare & contrast new places with the Compare Places feature. A new, gamified element has been added to let students guess at some of the facts with sounds and colors to give feedback.



## Educator Tools:


