

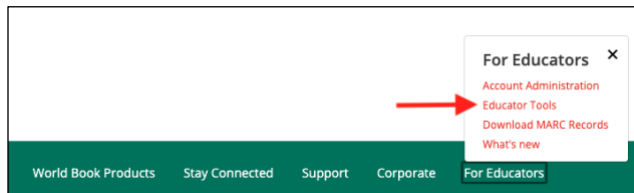
HOW TO LOCATE MATERIALS BY STANDARD

1. Log in to the desired resource.



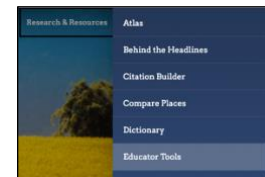
2. Click on **Educator Tools**, found in the bottom toolbar.



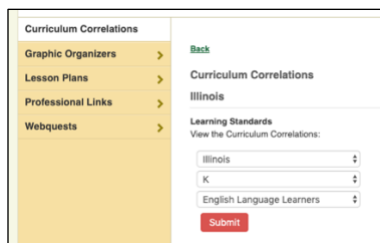

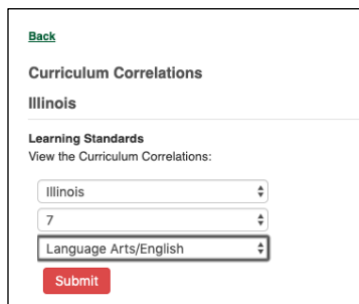


3. Select **Curriculum Correlations**.
