- Lesson Plans can be found under Educator Tools.
- Help pre-emergent readers learn to read and build phonemic awareness with the read aloud function in *Early Learning* and *eBooks*.
- Use World Book as a safe, trusted source to model research in real-time on the Smart Board.
- Discussion questions found on articles can be used as comprehension questions or as pre and post reading questions.


